

## 2026 "Edward W. Mohr" Scholarship Application

## 1. Qualification Requirements

- a. Applicant must be a son, daughter, grandson, or granddaughter of a member in good standing of the Greater Cincinnati Electrical Association
- b. Applicant must be enrolled in or accepted by, or already a student of any two or four-year accredited institute of higher learning.
- c. Applicant is NOT required to pursue a field relating to electricity
- d. Previous year applicants may re-apply unless they are a past recipient of a GCEA Scholarship.

### 2. Selection

a. Applicants will be judged based on character, personality, academics, extra-curricular activities, hobbies, need, and work experience.

### 3. Award

- a. The amount of each scholarship awarded will be \$2000. Each award is to be applied towards **tuition and/or room and board only**. Payment of the award will be made by check addressed to both the student and the registrar or bursar of the chosen institute of higher learning.
- b. Each scholarship is for one year and is not renewable.
- c. All scholarship award winners will be notified by the Scholarship Committee of the GCEA by May 1, 2026.
- d. Successful candidates will be recognized and presented their awards at the GCEA Golf Outing and dinner on June 8, 2026, at the Aston Oaks Golf Course in North Bend, OH This golf outing funds the GCEA Edward W. Mohr Scholarship and the John Schoenfeld Tool Bag Award.
